



2024 KenKen (Fuzhou) Open Championship

(11-13 October 2024)

The Fujian Provincial Commission for Promotion of Sudoku (FPCPS) will host China's first international KenKen championship in the southeastern Fuzhou City, Fujian Province between 11th and 13th October 2024.







Championship Awards

1st Place winner: A trophy and Medal Plus ¥ 7,000.00

 2^{nd} Place winner: Medal plus $\frac{1}{2}$ 3,000.00

3rd Place winner: Medal plus ¥ 2,000.00

(¥7,000.00 is closely equivalent of \$1,000 US dollars or €1,000.00)









The FPCPS would like to invite all **KenKen lovers** to join it. The registration and participation fees are \$100.00 US Dolla for the 2-day event. The fees cover 2-night local 4-star hotel, food, airport/train station transport, local sightseeing tour and event and local souvenirs that is worth of \$50.00 US dollars.



But the FPCPS would like to send special invitation to 20 foreign players for the championship who will be offered a VIP status, i.e. FREE 4-star hotel accommodation, local transport and sightseeing tours, and event souvenirs during the championship time. They only need to pay for the registration fee of \$30.00 US dollars.








Two conditions are set for the VIP status:



- (1) The players must be involved in major national or international Sudoku or KenKen events in the past as well as in the coming 17th World Sudoku Championship, or to be recommended by Mr Robert Fuhrer, the Chairman of International KenKen Federation.
- (2) A non-refundable registration fee of \$30.00 US dollars must be paid to the FPCPS. The payment means the seriousness of his/her determination and engagement so as to enable the FPCPS to keep the hotel and local tour bookings ready upon his/her arrival.











In the meantime, The FPCPS expects about 200 domestic players. Their qualification for the championship mainly depends on their involvements in different competitions or tournaments in the past. They and any other foreign players will pay for their own accommodation and other cost.



The FPCPS puts the limit over the numbers of participants because it has never organised international events to this regard and the organising committee would like to control the balance of the KenKen open championship so as to give all the participants a very good experience in Fuzhou.







Other Awards

Medals and Certificates for top three of aged 60 and over; Medals and Certificates for top three of aged 12 to 17; Medals and Certificates for top three of aged 8 to 11.







Winning rules

All participants will use the same set of competition test papers and their places will be decided by their individual scores of all or among their own groups.



The Fuzhou Overseas Chinese Middle School, the best local middle school in Fuzhou City is one of the sponsors, who has organized many sudoku events.















Their big auditorial hall is to be used as the main competition venue for the event where 300 hundred participants will be housed for the day.













By Air: There is a state-of-art airport in Fuzhou called Fuzhou Changle International Airport with the airport code FOC. So far it has direct flights from and to 19 foreign destinations plus 94 domestic destinations. Check if there is a direct flight from your country to Fuzhou (FOC).

Alternatively, you can choose Hong Kong as a transit hub. You can either fly from Hong Kong to Fuzhou or travel by high-speed train. Or you can also use lots of places as transit points for Fuzhou, such as Beijing,

Guangzhou, Shenzhen, Shanghai. Buying air tickets inside China is very cheap as there are more than 20 domestic airlines compete with each other.









Transit By Air from Hong Kong:

There are 3 direct flights from HKG to FOC between 11:00 and 21:00 cost €80.00 Euros or 90 US dollars, which takes one and half hours.













Transit By Train from Hong Kong:

There is one direct high-speed train from HK to Fuzhou leaving at 14:00 hours and get to 19:50 hours with train fare of €55.00 Euros. But there are 24 trains from HK to Fuzhou transit via Shengzhen North station where you do not need to go out and just walk into the transit waiting room to find the right platform for the train. You will be there in a bout 5 hours.









How to get to Beijing?

If you need to go to Beijing after the KenKen Open Championship,, you have two choices: by air or by train.

By Air from FOC to Beijing:

There are 141 direct flights from FOC to Beijing between 6:50 and 22:00 cost from €105.00 Euros or 115.00 US dollars for the 3-hour journey.









How to get to Beijing?



By Train from Fuzhou to Beijing:

There are 13 high-speed trains starting from 7:23 to 15:15, the journey time of which varies from 7 hours to 9 hours and costs about €96.00 Euros or 100.00 US dollars one direct high-speed train from HK to Fuzhou leaving at 14:00. Also there is a night train with sleeping cabin ticket of €68.00, leaving at 19:43 and arriving in Beijing next day at 12:30 (16-hour journey).
